In 1994, golf course designer Gil Hanse, then a novice, was commissioned for a redesign of the course. His innovative approach to bunker design became a signature style in his career. Over time, the course underwent a complete restoration, maintaining its classic layout and now serving as a prime example of traditional Philadelphia golf course architecture.

Today, the Club is owned and operated by Ron Jaworski Golf. It remains Semi-Private, with over 200 members and hosts more than 43,000 rounds of golf annually. The on-site restaurant, Seven Tap Tavern, serves the public seven days a week, offering a welcoming atmosphere for both golfers and visitors. The Club also boasts a thriving banquet operation, hosting up to 80 weddings annually and generating over \$3 million in food and beverage revenue.
